3D Project	The 3D project is a topic on recycling which is based around the National Curriculum subjects of science, literacy and dance. Within these subjects we will be learning how and why we recycle. We will be incorporating a visit to the Material Recycling Centre and a second trip to carry out a Garbology dig. In Literacy we will be covering personification in poetry and persuasive writing. In science we will be investigating the properties of materials and in dance will be performing dances relating to the movements of machines and litter. We will be working towards a presentation showing what we have learnt about recycling incorporating the three curriculum areas.
