### Let's pretend

We will be reading and retelling some traditional tales, acting them out and discussing the language used; writing our own versions and making class books of stories; using stories as a focus for movement and drama lessons; looking at story settings and designing sets for storytelling.

We will also be finding out about puppets, how they move and where they come from; making a selection of puppets and using them to make up and perform puppet plays.

### Houses and Homes

We will be looking at houses and other buildings in the local environment; finding out about homes of different types and those in different countries; finding out about life in a castle; making model buildings; finding out about animal homes; looking at everyday household objects including some used in the past.

#### Year 1

1. Suffolk Empty Number Line programme units looking at numbers to 20 (and beyond), addition and subtraction with numbers to 20, some place value work and doubling of numbers to 10+10.
